Career Assessment Instructions

1. Log in to your Agguelink account to obtain the license code for MyPlan. It will be listed on the main page in the *News Feed* section. Write the code down for later use.
2. Go to: www.ncat.myplan.com and click the assessment tab.
3. Click *new user* to create an account using your N.C. A&T email address.
4. On the last page of the registration form, you will be required to enter the license code. Enter the code you obtained from AggieLink. **This code is only needed for the assessments.**
5. **Important:** Click the box to the right of the license code, which states “share results (assessments only) with licensed provider?” Career Services is the licensed provider.
6. Click *submit registration*. You can take up to three assessments at no charge. The *Skills Profiler* career assessment is required for all new and transfer students (effective June 2014).
