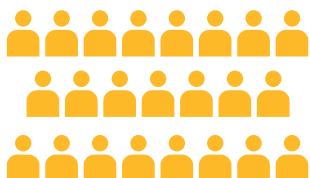
**AGRICULTURE AND NATURAL RESOURCES**



**4,465**  
SMALL-SCALE PRODUCERS improved crop production, farm management, and value-added enterprises.

**EMPOWERING COMMUNITIES**

**OVER \$75,000** was obtained by rural community organizations to improve community and economic development.



**162,707** youth were reached through 4-H programs, with **116 teachers** using 4-H STEM curriculum in their classrooms.
