ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

PREREQUISITES. Follow the sequence of the curriculum guide to ensure prerequisites are met. Many online course sections are often offered only once a year, requiring online students to carefully plan their matriculation to graduate on time.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS. If all requirements are not completed within six years after admission, the student is expected to conform to the University Bulletin requirements specified for the class with which graduation is anticipated. To graduate, students must earn a minimum of 120 semester hours in the specified curriculum, excluding deficiency and/or remedial courses, with a cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or better for all courses taken.

WITHDRAWALS/REPEATS. Students may withdraw from a total of only five courses throughout their entire degree. Withdrawals count as course attempts. Students may repeat a single course only two times. A total of 16 credits can be repeated throughout a student's entire degree.
